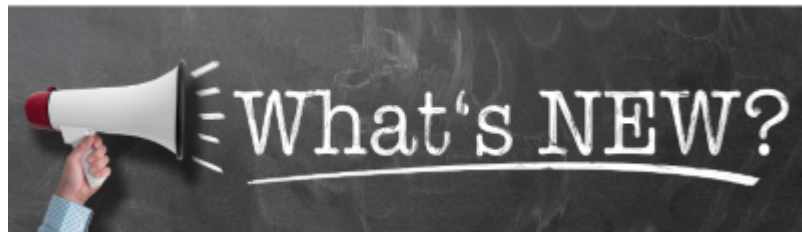

Miss Mary's Ice Cream Cranker for the Drake House August 25


