

GROUP VI FOUNDER JIM PACE SPEAKS



Jim Pace, Founder of Group VI in Peachtree City, used examples of Group VI projects to underscore his company's business approach. He said that a key to success is to, "Be alert to opportunities!" Pace explained that one of their current projects – construction of the Pinewood Atlanta Studios on Sandy Creek Road in Fayette County – underscored that being alert to an opportunity and being flexible to respond to prospective client and investor needs can pay huge dividends. The Pinewood project is a 288-acre full-service film and entertainment studio complex of 5 sound stages, workshops, and offices that will add to Georgia's growing presence in the film industry. Group VI was able to provide UK-based Pinewood Studios officials with investment partners and real estate options for establishing the studio facility in Fayette County. Pace looks for the facility to become a huge revenue source.


WELCOME TO OUR NEWEST ROTARIANS
